Required Information

All of your application material and supporting documents must be received by the Education Admissions Office on or before the application deadline. These documents include:

- **A completed application form** for admission to the program; the deadline for fall admission is on or before January 15;
- **A letter of rationale** which details your desire/passion to teach, and linking that passion to your experiences with children. Rationales should be two to three pages in length;
- **Three (3) references** who assess your suitability for the teaching profession in terms of your character, your personal qualities, and your ability to work with young people. Reference letters should be sealed and sent directly from the referee to the Education Admissions Office. Note: no family members, please;
- A list of your **previous teaching/leadership experience** with children in a resume format;
- **Official transcripts** from ALL post-secondary institutions you have attended. Crandall students need not submit their Crandall transcript. Students with post-secondary coursework outside of North America must have it assessed by World Education Service (WES) and this assessment sent to Crandall through WES. Students applying for the Bachelor of Technical Education degree must submit Red Seal documentation;
- **Disclosure of Criminal Record** information, including a vulnerable sector check. This can be obtained through your local RCMP detachment or policing agency;
- **A non-refundable \$50 application fee** must be included with this application. Make cheques and money orders payable to Crandall University;
- If accepted, applicants are requested to contact the Registrar's Office with any requests for, or questions about, physical or documented learning disabilities and available accommodations.
