



## Instructional Support Graduate Studies

<b>Academic Rank:</b>	Two renewable, limited term (three-to-five year) contractual appointment (LTCA) faculty positions as Senior Lecturer or Assistant Professor.
<b>Salary &amp; Benefits:</b>	Based on education and experience per the Crandall University Faculty Handbook. (approximate range \$61,000 – \$85,000). Includes a generous benefits and retirement package.
<b>Application Deadline:</b>	Applications will continuously be reviewed until the positions are filled.
<b>Starting Dates:</b>	July 1, 2023
<b>Qualifications:</b>	A PhD, DBA, or appropriate graduate degree or professional designation.
<b>Particulars of the Positions:</b>	<p>To be considered for appointment candidates must be committed to facilitating teaching from a Christian perspective and to the mission and the statement of faith of the university.</p> <p>The successful candidate will be assigned the responsibility to support online student learning by facilitating discussion and grading student assessments for online courses.</p> <p>This position will expect candidates to be able to function within a multi-disciplinary approach to studies in management.</p>
<b>Assignment:</b>	Nineteen facilitation cohorts per year plus additional assignments in curricular or co-curricular duties related to the strength of the candidate and the needs of the university in the areas of theatre arts or organizational structure and governance.
<b>Other Duties:</b>	Successful candidates are expected to be involved in service to the university which may include serving as academic advisors to a group of students, and functioning on at least one university committee. A service role toward their church and community is expected according to an individual's gifts and interests.

Qualified candidates should submit the following as part of the application portfolio (incomplete applications will not be processed): a letter of application indicating the reason of interest and capability for successfully completing the assignments for the position, an up-to-date CV, evidence of the ability to effectively use on-line communication platforms, a one page statement outlining a philosophy of on-line learning for adult learners, a one or two page statement describing their faith commitment and how it shapes their professional work, and the names of three references to:
