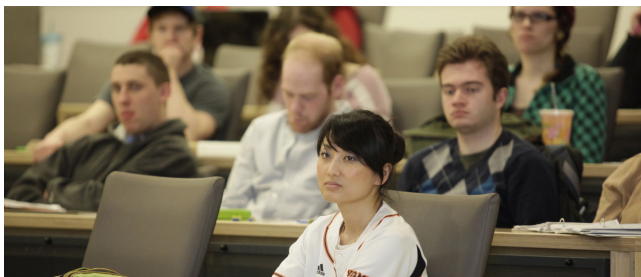

Practical elements in the program will provide students the opportunity to serve and lead locally and internationally.

What to expect when you graduate
