Required Information

All your application material and supporting documents must be received by the Education Admissions Office on or before the application deadline. These documents include:

- A completed B.Ed. application form for admission to the program;
- A letter of rationale which details your desire/passion to teach, and linking that passion to your experiences with children. Rationales should be two to three pages in length;
- Three B.Ed. references forms which assess your suitability for the teaching profession in terms of your character, your personal qualities and your ability to work with young people. References should be sealed and sent directly from the referee to the Education Admissions Office. Please use the reference forms provided. *Note: No family members please;*
- A list of your previous teaching/leadership experience with children in a resume format;
- A resume of all previous work experience;
- Official transcripts from **ALL** post-secondary institutions you have attended. These include letters of standing from apprenticeship bodies;
- Disclosure of Criminal Record information, including a vulnerable sector check. This can be obtained through your local RCMP detachment or policing agency;
- **A non-refundable \$50 application fee must be included with this application.** Make cheques and money orders payable to Crandall University;
- If accepted, applicants are requested to contact the Registrar's Office with any requests for, or questions about, physical or documented learning disabilities and available accommodations;
