Note: No family members please; • A list of your previous teaching/leadership experience with children in a resume format; • Official transcripts from ALL post-secondary institutions you have attended. Crandall students need in submit their Crandall transcript; • Disclosure of Criminal Record information, including a vulnerable sector check. This can be obtained through your local RCMP detachment or policing agency; • A non-refundable \$50 application fee must be included with this application. Make chequiand money orders payable to Crandall University; • If accepted, applicants are requested to contact the Registrar's Office with any requests for, or question about, physical or documented learning disabilities and available accommodations.
